If You're Approved

The following are incorporated into the Adoption Agreement which each adoptive family must sign. Your signature on this application signifies your acceptance of these requirements and your agreement to abide by them. Your signature also serves as authorization for your veterinarian to release information to a GPA Tri-State representative regarding your care of current and past pets.

- 1. The adoption donation is \$300.
- 2. The greyhound must be kept solely as a pet. His or her racing career cannot be reactivated.
- 3. The greyhound must be kept on a leash outdoors unless in a fully enclosed area.
- 4. The greyhound must never be tied to a stationary object or a tie-out cable/chain.
- 5. Identification must be kept on the greyhound at all times. Tags must include a tag from GPA Tri-State and a tag with the owner's current contact information on it. An alternative or additional form of identification may be a collar embroidered with the owner's current contact information.
- 6. Your greyhound is microchipped. It is up to the adopter to register and maintain contact information with the microchip company.
- 7. Adopter will notify GPA Tri-State immediately if the dog becomes lost.
- 8. If the adopter can no longer keep the greyhound, he or she will return the dog to GPA Tri-State.
- 9. Adopter will provide the dog with proper nutrition and veterinary care including, but not limited to, regular examinations, dental care, and vaccinations in accordance with American Animal Hospital Association guidelines.
- 10. Adopter will answer any inquiries from a GPA Tri-State representative about the status of the greyhound promptly.
- 11. Adopter will inform GPA Tri-State of any change in address, phone number, email, or other contact information.

Once the review of the application and references has been completed satisfactorily, I/we understand that a home visit will be scheduled to complete the application process. By submitting this application, I/we agree to a scheduled home visit and confirm that all members of the household will attend the home visit. I/we agree that if this application is approved, it will become part of the GPA Tri-State Greyhound Adoption Agreement. I/we also certify that all information provided in this application is true and correct.
